

We are looking forward to meeting you at our "All Different, All Same" training course, organized by Buruciye GED and powered by the Erasmus + program.

It will take place from the 17th of June to the 22nd of June 2023. The training will gather 16 participants coming from Turkiye, Italy, Slovakia, Czech Republic. To give you an idea of the whole process of the project, we have prepared this Info pack for you.

In this pack, you will find the information you need about the project, especially logistic issues, to help you to prepare the training course and your arrival in Turkiye. Please read it carefully. If you still have some questions, don't hesitate to contact us.

### Summary of The Project

Disabled people are a population group that has difficulty in socially, psychologically, and physically integrated into their environment in many societies, and often face serious difficulties and obstacles in the environment they live in. Therefore, as the world is in many countries of Turkiye also accepted the existence of the social structure in the quality of life of people with disabilities, based on participation and decision-making abilities, protection, there is a need to support the intervention and inclusion strategy. Especially, it is of great importance to develop serious and effective dialogue mechanisms in order to strengthen the dialogue between the disabled youth and decision-makers, to increase the dignity of the disabled by being noticed in the society, and to increase the self-confidence and solidarity of these individuals.

Our goals we want to achieve with the project:

- 4 To contribute to the awareness of the disabled people about the problems they face in their education and social life,
- 4 To generate employment ideas to encourage disabled people to participate in economic life after their education.
- + To create a policy document on policies and laws that support the right to work of the disabled.
- To raise awareness about the rights that disabled people already have,







- 4 To encourage the organization of more activities by public / private institutions and NGOs to ensure the integration of disabled people into social, political, and cultural life,
- Providing space for participants to actively manage their learning processes by using common and informal methods by strengthening the awareness of active citizenship among people with disabilities.

Youth Participation Projects is directly related to the aim of promoting their participation in democratic life in Europe, remodeling the participation process of the policies developed for the youngsters, and it is one of the main objectives of the future of Turkiye. In addition, within the scope of the Youth Participation projects, our project supports the strengthening of cooperation through these dialogue opportunities by bringing together young people, and organizations active in youth work and youth policymakers, and it is one of the common points between the project and the program objectives.

#### Activity Schedule

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Within the scope of the project, activities will be carried out through 4 workshops, 4 discussions, and digital democracy tools. A series of one-week educational and social activities will be organized during Disability Week.



#### Accommodation

If participants will spend less than the below mentioned amounts, they will be only covered for the amount they spent. The reimbursement will be done at the end of the project in cash in Euro ( $\in$ ). If not, after the project, by bank transfer. According to the restrictions of the Erasmus+ Program, we can only refund the travel cost, if the following points are fulfilled:


There are 2 airports one of them Sabiha Gökçen Airport (SAW) other is Istanbul Airport (İST) in İstanbul if you want to come to Sivas directly (or connected) by plane. If you can find a direct flight to Ankara (ESB) or Kayseri (ASR) you can use train or bus to arrive the final







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destination (Sivas). If you prefer to come by plane, you can reach the city center by using the private buses or airport taxis located outside the Sivas Nuri Demirağ Airport.

Note: We need your all receipts, tickets, and boarding passes (for both ways). So, when you are coming, keep them. After the project you should send us (scanned by email and originals by post) all the tickets and boarding passes of the travel back home from Turkiye (for flight you must bring invoice + ticket + boarding pass, without one of them we can't reimburse).

#### About Sivas

Sivas, which is known by names such as Sebaste, Sipas, Megalopolis, Kabira, Diaspolis, Talaurs in various periods, is one of the oldest and most important settlement centers of Anatolia. The first settlement in the region dates back to the Neolithic Age (8000-5500 BC). The foundations of the republic were laid here with the decisions taken at the Sivas Congress held in Sivas High School/Sultanisi on September 4, 1919. Sivas has been under the rule of Hittite, Cimmerian, Scythian, Med, Persian, Roman, Seljuk, Ilkhanid and Ottoman throughout history. The architectural style of the city bears many features of the Seljuk period. The madrasahs, which are masterpieces with their stonework and decorations, have remained standing up to the present and reflect the character of the city.









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There are historical buildings in the city center such as Double Minaret, Gök Madrasa, Congress Museum, Buruciye Madrasa.

There are also natural places to visit such as Yıldız Mountain Ski Center, Tödürge Lake, Gökpınar lake and Hafik lake.
